


# CONSEQUENCES OF BEING UNINSURED



84 million (half of all working-age U.S. adults) – went without health insurance and spent out-of-pocket costs for LTC in 2012

## FINANCIAL BURDENS

About 67% who were uninsured were reported having cost-related problems getting needed care in 2012



The uninsured pay for more than one-third (35%) of their care out-of-pocket.





53% of caregivers in 2012 had lost personal time


## NOT GETTING THE RIGHT TYPE OF CARE

52% of care recipients stated they experienced a high degree of stress from LTC



Adults who were uninsured were less likely to receive recommended preventive care in 2012



## NOT HAVING A REGULAR SOURCE OF CARE



One-quarter (25%) of uninsured adults go without needed care each year due to cost.

The uninsured are at higher risk for preventable hospitalizations and for missed diagnoses of serious health conditions.

## NOT HAVING ACCESS TO FACILITIES NEEDED

In 2012, 2 of 5 adults tend to not go to a doctor when sick or not filling a prescription due to high costs.

5.6% - The percentage of uninsured people in Massachusetts, the lowest of any state.



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
